EVANGELISM





I came to Christ as a teenager at a summer youth camp ten weeks after I was checked out of a hospital on Easter Sunday. As a teen, I experimented with drugs and later called my dad at work and told him I wanted to kill myself.

Young people from a local church invited me to camp and the last night, June 21, 1973, I received Jesus Christ as my Savior. The night I came to Christ, God called me to preach. My mother and father received Christ after they heard me give my testimony at church. I would have never come to Christ without the church!

Three months later I joined the Youth for Christ Preacher Boy Club and 22 students received Christ the first nig t I spoke at my YFC Club. God gave me a burden for my public school. In one year, we led over 200 of our classmates to faith in Jesus Christ. From the very beginning, I was an evangelist. I simultaneously graduated from a Bible Institute where I learned critical Bible doctrine.

YFC's Executive Director, Dr. Al Metsker, asked me to be their Evangelist-at-Large and sent me to preach in Youth for Christ rallies and clubs from Los Angeles to New York while I was still in high school. Dr. Metsker introduced me to Dr. Jerry Falwell, Sr. and he gave me a seven-year scholarship to Liberty. While in college, I served as his associate evangelist and preached in over 90 cities in local churches. Dr. Falwell asked me to preach on his nationally syndicated Sunday television show on 390 T.V. stations. My sermon was titled The Fear and Holiness of God.





- Evangelist-at-Large for KC Youth for Christ while in high school, spoke hundreds of times in YFC rallies, churches, and camps nationwide.
- Associate Evangelist for Dr. Jerry Falwell, Sr. while on scholarship at Liberty University. Preached on Dr. Falwell's nationally syndicated television show on 390 stations.
- Conducted evangelistic events in 1,200 churches in over 700 cities in the USA, Canada, Korea, Germany, the United Kingdom, and the Netherlands.
- Spoke in 2,000 public schools, private academies, and universities to over 3MM young people and invited students to evangelistic events where thousands came to faith in Jesus Christ.
- Witnessed over 125,000 recorded public professions of faith in Christ.
- Interviewed on 520 radio/TV programs on culture trends and topics derived from 13 authored books.
- Preached at Billy Graham's North American Conference for Itinerate Evangelists on the topic, "How to Prepare and Deliver an Evangelistic Sermon," in Louisville, KY.
- Preached at the Billy Graham School of Evangelism at Wheaton College, Wheaton, IL and Denver, CO during the Billy Graham Crusade.
- Preached at the Southern Baptist Convention Pastor's Conference with Dr. Adrian Rogers in St. Louis, MO, to 14,000 pastors.

It's a rarity when the Lord selects someone so very young to do such a very important work

Jerry Johnston is only 18 years of age.

I know all the dangers that surround the ministry of a young person—the dangers of pride, the foolishness of immaturity, and all the things that can injure and damage a ministry before it ever gets off the launching pa $\,$.

Jerry Johnston is also aware of these things. He's accepted counsel, listened to his elders, and, for his age, I think he is probably the most mature young man I know. He is yielded to the Lord.

He has repeatedly told me, 'I want nothing in my life but that which honors my Christ. I want the Holy Spirit to lead me.'

I was glad when Jerry decided to come to Liberty Baptist College. I was glad when he said, 'I want to go to college. I want to finish the seminary here, I want to get my doctorate, I want to get all the training possible because I want to be a polished shaft in the hand of the Lord.'

So tonight, I want you to carefully and prayerfully listen to a young man I believe the world is going to hear from. I hope with these statements, each of you will bear him up in prayer. I suppose if Satan is ever going to destroy the ministry of Jerry Johnston, he will try to do it quickly. In the early budding days of his ministry so he needs our prayers probably more now than he will ever need them later. I want you to pray for Jerry Johnston, and I want you to listen as he preaches the word of God to you now."
