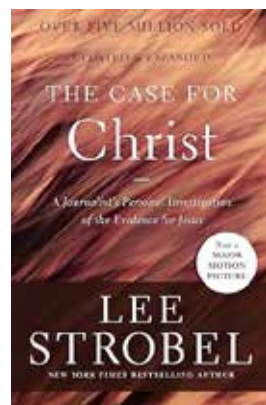

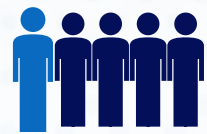

Weak believers do not faithfully attend church, serve, give, or share and defend their faith.

The largest demographic, “nones,” the religiously disaffiliated, are at 28% - over 50M adult Americans have left the church since 1974.^[2] “The nones pop out as kind of a megatrend.”^[3]



We are losing Generation Z (1995 – 2012). For the first time, fewer than 1 out of 4 high school seniors attended religious services once a week.^[4] In late 2020 and early 2021, Gen Z was the only generation in which the majority believe there are more than two genders.”^[5]



LifeWay’s multiyear study revealed that 70 – 88% of young people raised in church leave after their freshman year of college.^[6]



According to the latest data from Gallup, More than half of Americans (56%) say they seldom or never attend religious services. Less than a third (30%) say they attend on a weekly or almost weekly basis.”^[7]

THE FIRST TRULY **POST-CHRISTIAN** GENERATIONS

Gen Z (Born 1995 – 2012) / **75 million** – 23% of U.S. Population

Gen ALPHA (Born 2013 – 2029) / **Largest/Most Educated Generation** in History

- A person’s worldview is most often in place by age 13. (Barna)
- 2/3 of Gen Z said they are increasingly supportive of transgender rights.
- Gen Z young adults are much more likely to identify as either trans or nonbinary than other generations. (Household Pulse Survey, 2021)
- 400,000 14 to 18-year-olds in the U.S. identified as transgender in the late 2010s. (CDC Youth Risk Behavior Surveillance System, 2017)
- In 2021, 16% (1 out of 6) identified as something other than straight, changes driven almost exclusively by an increase in bisexual females. (CDC, 2021)
- By 2021, in the CDC teen study, 1 out of 4 high school girls with sexual experience had had a same-sex partner.
- Gen Z is marrying and having children later than any previous generation in American history. (Vital Statistics Reports, CDC)
- By 2020, the birth rate for teens and women in their early 20s was the lowest since records were first kept in 1918—half of what it was in 1990.
- Twice as many teens were taking their own lives in 2019 than just 12 years earlier, and three times as many kids in the 4th to 9th grades died by suicide. (WISQARS, CDC)
- Social media and depression are inseparably linked. The average teen spent more than 8 ½ hours a day with screen media in total in 2021. (Common Sense Media)

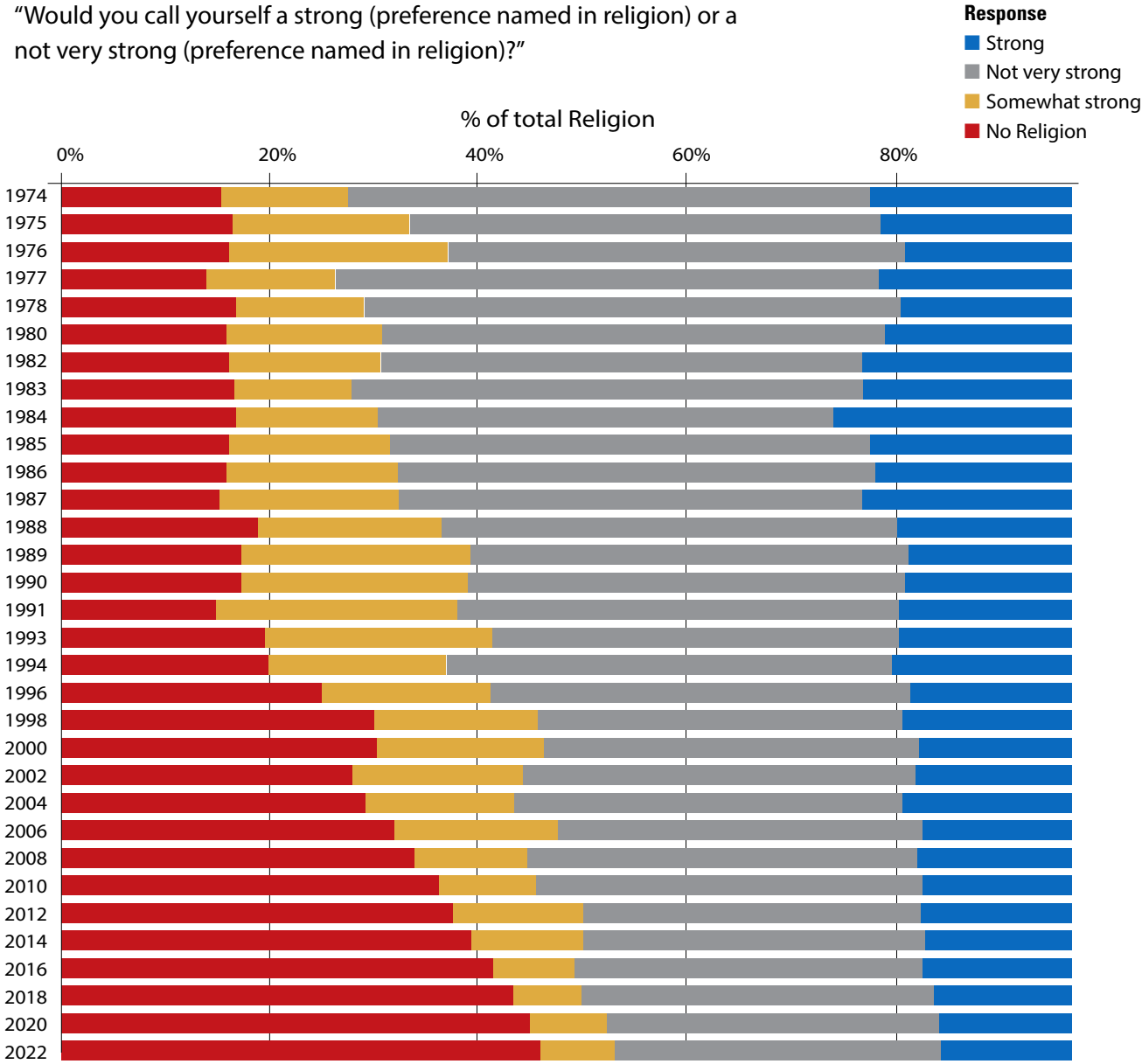

According to the General Social Survey data, it is strikingly consistent that, year after year from 1974 to 2022, only one in five people of faith rate their faith as “strong.” Conversely, during the same duration the **nones** have been on a dramatic increase.

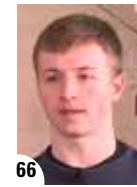

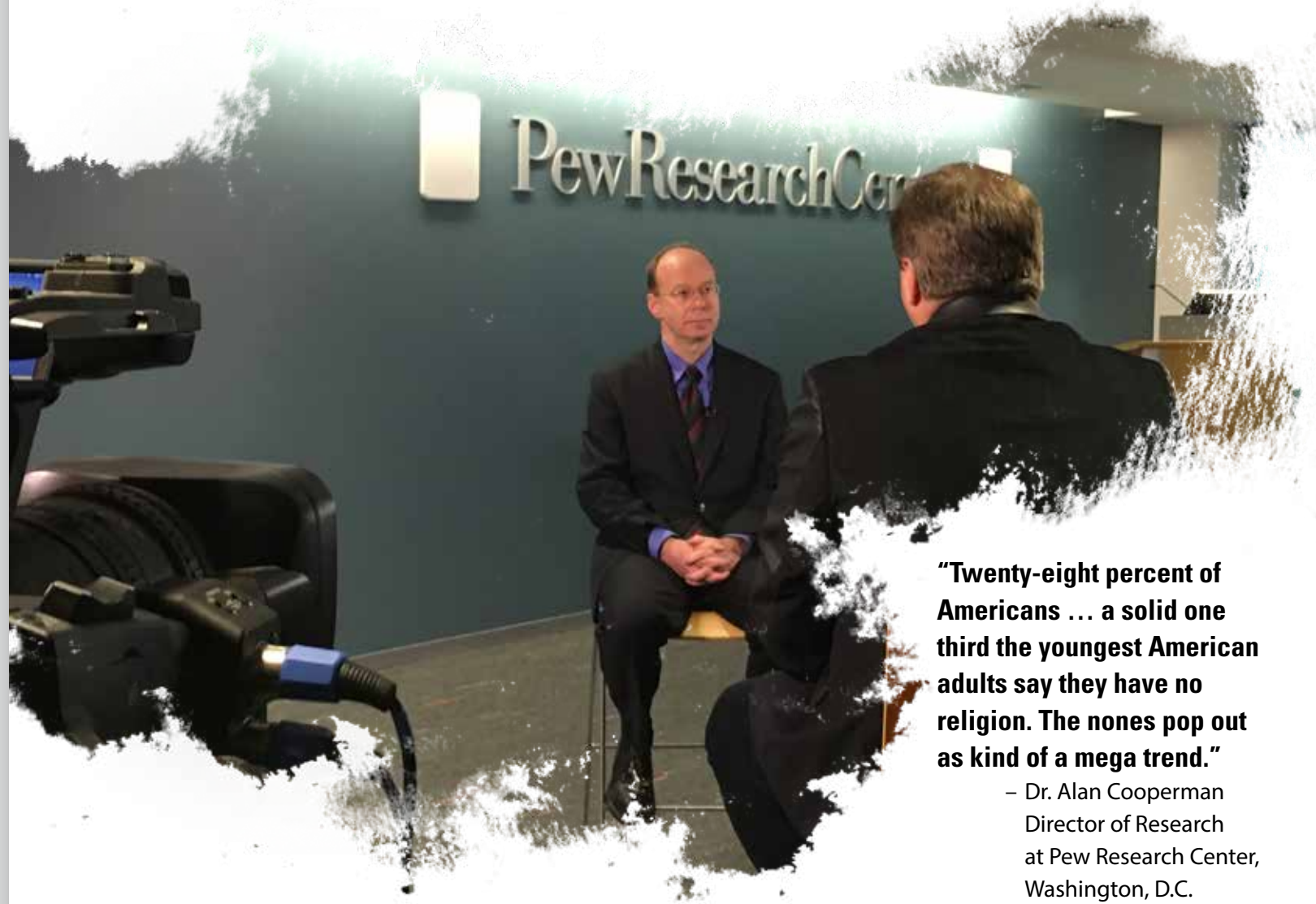
